- Trail Expansion
 - No Tap extension will be staked once dry – Henry is in charge of this
 - No update on Cochran to Ryan Expansion – awaiting city approval

- 10th St bridge is going to be connected to the trail system – permission granted and will be construction next year
- Broadwater boat launch to Central Ave is still moving ahead – city working land swap
- GFHS team and bikes
 - Looking to put 25 bikes to use with a 1st time ride day rental; skills park day (city will let us use their insurance); High School kids use if a team is set-up
- Bike Advisory Board
 - The board positions would work with the city on potential projects in GF to ensure bike safety and use is considered. John is the project engineer
